2. Our supplier has provided the following information (original text):

1. Restriction of Hazardous Substances (Article 5)

Heavy metals

The supplier hereby declares that, in the production of the adhesive tapes supplied to you, no intentional use is made of substances listed in Directive 94/62/EC .

The fact that such substances are not intentionally introduced into the products does not exclude the possibility that they may be present in trace amounts as a result of the specific characteristics of raw materials and/or the production and adhesive coating processes used in the manufacture of the product.

PFAS

The supplier declares that no intentional use is made in the production of the adhesive tapes supplied to you of per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS).

Any unintentional traces resulting from raw materials or upstream production processes are not subject to specific monitoring within the Quality Management System.

REACH Regulation

The supplier, as a downstream user, has implemented the necessary measures to ensure compliance with the applicable obligations under Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 (REACH).

Based on the information received from its suppliers and with reference to the latest update of the Candidate List available at the date of issue of this declaration, the products supplied do not contain substances of very high concern (SVHC) in concentrations above the thresholds established by the applicable legislation.

2. Minimisation of substances of concern

The products are designed and manufactured to minimise, to the extent technically possible, the presence of substances of concern, in accordance with the principles and objectives set out in Regulation (EU) 2025/40.

3. Information on recyclability and labelling (Articles 6 and 15)

The supplier continuously monitors the evolution of the requirements set out in Regulation (EU) 2025/40 concerning packaging recyclability and the related harmonised labelling system.

As of the date of this declaration, the assessment of product recyclability in accordance with the specific criteria established under the PPWR is still ongoing, pending the full availability of the implementing methodologies and implementing acts provided for under the Regulation.

With regard to environmental labelling, the company continues to apply the applicable national provisions in force and the operational guidance provided by the competent authorities, including the criteria for identifying packaging materials under Italian legislation.

- In the case of unprinted tapes, environmental information is provided on the packaging and/or in the accompanying product documentation.
- In the case of printed tapes, labelling information may be shared with the customer and, where technically feasible, integrated directly into the product artwork, subject to mutual agreement between the parties.

4. Traceability information

The supplier guarantees the identification of the manufacturer, the product, and the relevant production batches.

In addition, procedures are in place to ensure product traceability throughout the supply chain, in accordance with the applicable requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40.
